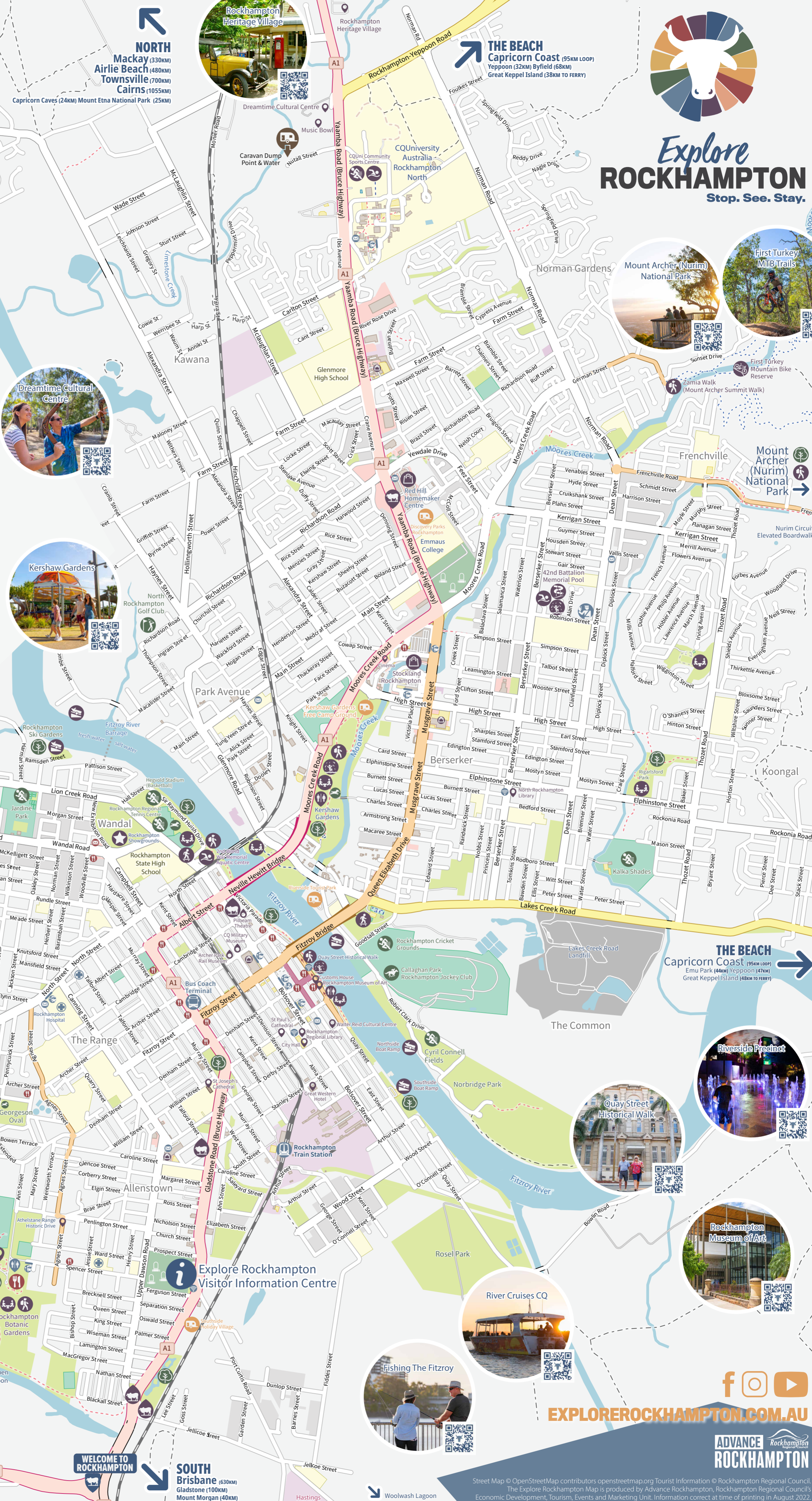
A physical, spiritual and emotional relationship, has existed between our country and ourselves from time immemorial.
